Dairyland Power Donates \$1,000 to Vernon County Sheriff's Department

LA CROSSE, WI— Dairyland Power Cooperative has donated \$1,000 to the Vernon County Sheriff's Department, which serves Dairyland's Genoa (Wis.) property. The Genoa Site property includes a coal-fired generating station, shut-down nuclear facility and dry cask storage installation.

"The Vernon County Sheriff's Department has provided excellent service to the Genoa Site over the years, and we are grateful for their dedication," said Lane Peters, Dairyland Manager, Genoa Site. "The sheriff's department is a very important part of our overall team working to keep Dairyland facilities safe and secure.
